CALL FOR PRAYER

Presbyterian minister and missionary to Turkey, Rev. Andrew Brunson, has been jailed without charges in Turkey since October 7, 2016. Rev. Brunson's wife was jailed the same day but later released. The Brunsons, both raised by missionary parents, have been serving in Turkey for over 23 years. No one knows why he was imprisoned by Turkish officials, no trial date has been set, no evidence presented, and no witnesses have been quoted. Rev. Brunson has simply disappeared into the Turkish prison system. Please pray for his safety, his timely release, his family, and his church in Turkey.
